



Robert Jay "Bob" Ramsey, 82, beloved father, husband, and grandfather, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, November 20, 2022. Bob was born on September 11, 1940, in Estherville, Iowa to the late James and Lois Ramsey. After graduating high school in 1958 Bob went to Colorado State University where he received his Bachelor of Science in Agriculture with a major in Animal Production in 1963. While attending Colorado State University Bob volunteered for the United States Marine Corps. He remained in the reserves until he was called for active duty and then later was discharged in 1967. Upon graduation Bob worked as a cattle buyer for John Morrill in Ottumwa Iowa. Bob then went

on to receive his Master of Science in Agriculture from Iowa State University in 1971. He worked for the Iowa State University Extension Service for over 36 years. For his last 17 years in the extension, he was an Area Extension Education Director and served twenty counties in Southwest Iowa before he retired in 2004. While attending Colorado State University Bob met his future wife, Glenda Crouch. They went on to get married in 1963 and later had three boys, Alan, Jon, and David.

Bob was a member of the Sandhills Baptist Fellowship in Ericson Nebraska. Bob enjoyed spending time with his family, watching his grandchildren in their activities, gardening, helping in the hayfield, and making sure his birds never went hungry.
