



Arnold Eugene Hoerle "Arnie" ,77, of Amelia, Nebraska passed away on Tuesday July 7th at his home. He was born on July 22, 1942 in Burwell, Nebraska to Leo and Lola (Chippis) Hoerle. As a child he attended District 22 country school and graduated from Wheeler County High School in 1960.
