



Glenda "Cookie" A. Ramsey, 78, died peacefully Sunday March 17, 2019 at Valley County Health System in Ord, Nebraska after a long battle with Multiple Sclerosis. Glenda was born on December 26, 1940 in Buffalo, Oklahoma to Glen & Inez Crouch. Glenda spent most of her childhood on the ranches that her father managed. During her freshman year her family moved from Laverne Oklahoma to Picayune, Mississippi. During her time in Mississippi Glenda was active in band and was an exceptional baton twirler and got to march in the Rose Bowl Parade. Her family moved from Picayune, Mississippi to San Luis, Colorado where Glenda graduated as salutatorian in 1959 from Centennial Union High School in San Luis, Colorado.

Glenda attended college at Adams State College in Alamosa, Colorado before transferring to Colorado State University. Glenda graduated in 1963 with a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Textiles and Clothing. On July 14, 1963 Glenda married Robert Ramsey. They were blessed with three sons. Her first job was a department manager at JCPenney in Ottumwa, Iowa. From June 1964 to December 1966 Glenda was employed as a Public Welfare Worker for the State Department of Social Services in Wapello County, Iowa. Glenda also worked as a social worker at Afton Care Center and also a nursing home in Creston, Iowa. Glenda and Robert moved to Atlantic, Iowa in 1987. After moving to Atlantic Glenda worked as a seamstress at a men's clothing store. Glenda and Robert moved from Atlantic, Iowa to Bartlett, Nebraska in 2008 to be closer to family.

Glenda was a member at the Sandhills Baptist Fellowship in Ericson, Nebraska. Glenda was an avid antique collector. She loved to sew and work in her flowerbeds. Glenda found joy in visiting with her family.

Glenda is survived by her husband Bob Ramsey of Bartlett, Nebraska, her sons Alan (Andrea) Ramsey of Bartlett, Nebraska, Jon (Melissa) Ramsey of Davis, California, and David (Lorie) Ramsey of Cincinnati, Ohio, her sister Joyce (Glen Dean) Lake of Buffalo, Oklahoma, her six grandchildren, Alesia, Michael, Cody, Nathan, Morgan, and Noah, four great-grandchildren, Jase, Kade, Kiah, and Grant, nieces and nephews.
