

Floyd Glen McClintic, 70, of Burwell, Nebraska died August 3, 2018 at his home.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 16, 2018 at the United Methodist Church in Burwell, Nebraska. Inurnment will be in Cottonwood Cemetery in Burwell. Floyd was a member of the VFW and the Disabled American Veterans.
