



Grant Charles Mann, 40, passed away suddenly on Thursday, December 9, 2021, near his home east of Alliance, Nebraska. He was born to Gaylord and Sandra Mann in Ogallala, Nebraska on March 6, 1981.

Grant spent most of his years growing up on the Mann Ranch near Taylor and graduated from Loup County High School in 1999.
